Grid Reference / Post Code	Junction of Woodhouse lane and New St Biddulph Moor 53°07'15.6"N 2°08'26.8"W
Brief Description	A small public area about 30yds by 10 yards that has a grassed area /Notice board/Old telephone kiosk housing defibrillator/flower beds/village green sign and carved rock

Criteria.		
Location <i>In reasonably close proximity to the community it serves</i>	√	Central to Biddulph Moor accessible by all when visiting post office / Newsagent / walking the dog/taking children to school/catching a bus
Local Significance <i>Demonstrably special to a local community and holds a particular local significance, for example because of its beauty, historic significance, recreational value (including as a playing field), tranquility or richness of its wildlife.</i>	√	It is the only green area in the centre of Biddulph Moor and is well used by many residents for functions throughout the year. Specifically at Easter week/Well dressing ceremony/Site for Christmas tree and Christmas decorations. The notice board is a central point to keep locals informed of events and occurrences in BM. Advertising boards can easily be erected when local events are occurring such as Bonfire c 5th Nov. The floral decorations enhance the area when visitors drive through or visit and the area is one of the recognised sites for the Biddulph in Bloom event
Size, Scale <i>Local in character and is not an extensive tract of land.</i>	√	The area is relatively small yet big enough to house the events named above. It can be maintained by local people without cost to the area and adds a little character with the old Telephone box and themed village sign.
Recommendation		Suitable for Local Green Space Designation
