Brief Description	Historic 'drying green' for centre of the village- terraced miners' houses. Used over the years for tea parties, recreational uses especially when the chapel was in use.

Small area of tranquillity in the middle of the terraced houses.
Size, Scale <i>Local in character and is not an extensive tract of land.</i>	√	Small field.
