

CHOOSING A FUNERAL DIRECTOR

Most people choose to entrust funeral arrangements to a professional funeral director. Partly for reasons of convenience, at what is generally a very stressful time, but also to make sure that the remains of their loved one are cared for with dignity and propriety.

Only funeral directors who have signed the council's terms and conditions will be granted permission to carry out interments at the burial ground.

Choosing a Funeral Director

- Ask for a detailed description of costs and a price list when getting a quote.
- Try and get quotes from more than one company.
- Check whether the funeral director is qualified and holds the diploma in funeral directing (Dip.Fd.) or a certificate in funeral practice (Cert.F.P).
- Find out whether they are a member of any of the trade associations: National Association of Funeral Directors (NAFD), The Society of Allied and Independent Funeral Directors (SAIF), The Funeral Standards Council (FSC).

There is no legal requirement to have any kind of funeral ceremony at all and no legal statutes governing what form any ceremony should take.

Funeral directors must ensure the deceased's family/representatives are provided with a copy of, and are aware of, the rules and regulations of the burial ground and the council's 'Burial Ground Management Policy.'
