

CHOOSING A GRAVE DIGGER

Biddulph Town Council doesn't directly employ grave diggers. A grave digger must be arranged directly (usually by the Funeral Director).

For safety reasons, only grave diggers authorised by the council may carry out work in the burial grounds. Grave diggers must follow the ICCM Code of Safe Working Practice for Cemeteries and must ensure the safety of all staff, contractors and visitors to the burial grounds as a result of their work.

Authorisation is only granted upon receipt of public liability insurance documents, and a signed agreement to the terms and conditions of working in the burial ground.
