Burial Grounds Opening Times

The gates to Woodhouse Burial Ground are open daily from 8.30am to 7pm. Pedestrians can access all sites at any time.

Toilets

There are no toilet facilities at the burial ground. The nearest public toilets are located in Biddulph town centre, unless St Lawrence's Church is open.

Water

Water points are provided for visitors use. Watering cans are provided at the taps. Please return them after use.

Dogs

Dogs are not permitted within the burial grounds, with the exception of assistance dogs. Assistance dogs must be kept on a lead at all times. Owners are responsible for cleaning up and disposing of any fouling appropriately.

Rubbish

Litter bins are situated around the burial grounds and should be used to dispose of all rubbish, except dog waste.

Parking

Please be considerate of other visitors when parking and do not park on grassed areas. Visitors are advised not to leave their vehicles unsecured. All vehicles are parked at the owner's risk. The burial grounds and car parks do not have lighting.

Bus Services

The burial grounds are served by the number 93 bus service. The stop is on the A527 Congleton Road, close to the burial ground gates.
